

***Adisianus* nom.nov. for a genus of Symphyleona (Insecta,  
Collembola) from Central Amazonia, Brazil**

**Abstract**

For *Adisius* BRETFELD, 2002, which is a homonym, a new name is proposed. In addition, three errata in BRETFELD (2002) are mentioned.

Keyword: **Collembola, Symphyleona, *Adisius*, *Adisianus*, homonym.**

**Resumo**

Para *Adisius* BRETFELD, 2002, que representa um homônimo, propos-se um novo nome. Adicionalmente indica-se três erros em BRETFELD (2002).

The generic name *Adisius* BRETFELD, 2002 is a junior primary homonym of *Adisius* FAIRMAIRE, 1903. Therefore, instead of *Adisius*, I propose the name *Adisianus* nom.nov., type species *Adisius maculatus* BRETFELD, 2002.

The diagnosis is the same as in the original description. The gender of the new name is masculine.

This new name is also dedicated to Prof. Dr. Joachim ADIS, Plön/Germany.

In addition, three errata in BRETFELD (2002) are mentioned:

- 1) In Table 1, p. 127, the numbers of Figs. 25 and 55 have to be mutually changed.
- 2) The complete legends of Table 1, p. 127, read:
  - Fig. 1: *Adisius maculatus* n.g. n.sp.; male colour pattern, length without furca 0.5 mm.
  - Fig. 18: *Adisius fuscus* n.g. n.sp.; male colour pattern, length without furca 0.55 mm.
  - Fig. 25 (erroneously called Fig. 55): *Arborianna cupiubae* n.g. n.sp.; male colour pattern, length without furca 0.5 mm.
  - Fig. 55 (erroneously called Fig. 25): *Sphyrotheca caputalba* n.sp.; female colour pattern, length without furca 0.6 mm.
  - Fig. 68: *Sphyrotheca coeruleocapitata* n.sp.; male colour pattern, length without furca 0.6 mm.
- 3) In Fig. 26, p. 131, the markings of the setal rows 'a' and 'b' of head frons have to be mutually changed ('a' is the outer row, 'b' the inner).
